


Wild Places Publishing

<u>Pioneers Beneath the Peak</u> by Martin Wright concerns exploration by cave diving within the Peak District. This is the story of those who would not be

stopped when water reached the roof of the passage and who, by a combination of determination, resourcefulness, technical innovation and a good measure of courage, sought to dive through those pools, to enter the unknown. This is a tale of true adventure and exploration, told by one of those involved. Martin is donating his royalties and all profits to the Derbyshire Cave Rescue Organisation.

We have been taking advance orders for the past few weeks, with both hardback and softback options. There's more information online by <u>following this link</u>, but note that the hardback has a limited print run. The great news is that the book is now in stock, so advance orders (and new ones) are scheduled to be posted next week. As they say, don't delay in placing an order, or see us at Hidden Earth. Martin will be available to sign copies.
